# HALDON HILL, WASTE CLEARANCE

Client	Teign Housing
Location	Exeter
Remediation Value	£61,000
Project	Removal of general waste and general site clearance
Contaminant	General waste including tyres, wood, plastic, metal and soils

## DESCRIPTION

Following the eviction of just over 70 vehicles and caravans from an illegal traveller's/new age encampment after eleven years of occupation, the site had been cleared by others but the arisings were left in two large stockpiles.

UK Remediation Limited were appointed to remove the stockpiled material from site so that the area could be topsoiled and seeded with grass to return it to an open park land.

Ideally the material would have been screened on site prior to disposal of the different waste streams. However, due to the site's location it was not possible to make it secure due to the high risk of vandalism and theft. This meant that plant and equipment could not be left there overnight.

As a result UK Remediation organised for the waste material to be loaded into large 20 and 40 yard skips for transportation to suitably licensed treatment facilities for processing, recycling and disposal.

The works were undertaken over a five day period with just over 340 tonnes of general waste being removed.

In addition to the removal of the stockpiled material UK Remediation also arranged to have further hand picking undertaken across the site and arranged for third parties to collect a large number of empty gas bottles.
